### Background

The GLOHRA Academy Series is a new format of the Global Health Academy that presents and discusses global health research from the perspectives of the different research disciplines of GLOHRA.

The Series directs special attention towards the added value of interdisciplinary, cross-sector and international cooperation in global health research. Every first Tuesday in a month, a speaker shares insights of his/her research projects while focusing on research processes, methods as well as lessons learned. Followed by the speaker's presentation, the Series encourages an academic exchange between the speaker and the audience in a Q&A session.

### Speaker

PD Dr. Eva Kantelhardt, a representative of the GLOHRA research discipline Biomedicine - Clinical Research, will present and discuss her research project on breast cancer care in Ethiopia.

Since her Ethiopian friend developed breast cancer, she realized that oncology is important in Africa and developed a strong research interest in cancer epidemiology, health service research in Africa, the unique African tumor biology, and interventions to improve outcomes. Her main goal has been to build an interdisciplinary team with a global view on cancer. In 2010, she and the Global Health Team at Martin-Luther-University Halle (Saale) started projects on awareness, screening, patient outcome, de-centralizing and task-shifting in oncology care, and investigating into tumor biology in Africa.
