### 2. Background

The GLOHRA Academy Series is a format of the Global Health Academy that presents and discusses global health research from the perspectives of the different research disciplines of GLOHRA.

Every first Tuesday in a month, a speaker shares insights of his/her research projects while focusing on research processes, methods as well as lessons learned. Following the speaker's presentation, the Series encourages an academic exchange between the speaker and the audience in a Q&A session.

### 3. Speaker

Dr. Daniela Fusco is a senior scientist at the Bernhard-Nocht-Institut für Tropenmedizin. She is a molecular biotechnologist with a PhD in Virology and has been working in basic biomedical science, as well as International and Global Health. She was involved in management and capacity building with Médecins Sans Frontières and coordinated a laboratory working group in the context of a phase II clinical trial for two vaccines against Ebola virus. Currently, she is the scientific coordinator of a phase III clinical trial studying the impact of a diagnostic strategy on women and children's health. Furthermore, she is the principal investigator of three additional research projects which are concerned with teaching, training and capacity building in LMICs.
