Following the speaker's presentation, the Series encourages an academic exchange between the speaker and the audience in a Q&A session.

3. Speaker

Prof. Chagunda is Chair of Animal Breeding and Husbandry in the Tropics and Subtropics at the University of Hohenheim. His area of interest is on the linkages and relationship among the food systems (focusing on livestock), sustainable livelihoods and health, and environmental wellbeing. He obtained a BSc and MSc from the University of Malawi before travelling to the University of Göttingen in Germany where he obtained Doctor of Agricultural Science degree with concentration in Quantitative Genetics. Prof. Chagunda worked as a postdoc in in Malawi and at the University of Aarhus in Denmark. From there, he moved to Scotland's Rural College in Scotland where among other work he engaged in international work in Malawi, Kenya, Tanzania, Ethiopia, Rwanda and Zambia.
