The German Alliance for Global Health Research (GLOHRA) is a proponent for interdisciplinary and collaborative global health research. GLOHRA funds interdisciplinary pilot projects, cross-sector projects and global health postdoc fellowships to support the development and implementation of groundbreaking ideas and of new models of cooperation between disciplines and communities. The next deadline for research project submissions is 28 February 2022.
