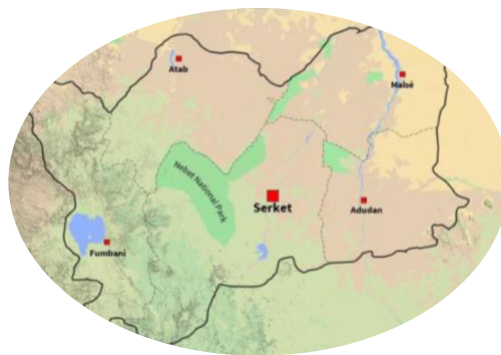
- Simulation Game on NTDs | **online on 22 November 2024** | 10-16 CET

## 2. Program

### Participation in the Simulation Game

Sekertia is a Simulation Game which aims to shed light on the interplay of social, technical, medical, psychological, economic, and political factors in the fight against Neglected Tropical Diseases (NTDs). The scenario is set in a fictional Central African country involving diverse stakeholders from local communities to international agencies. Participants will develop a context-adapted action plan incorporating multiple different stakeholder interests. More information [here](#).



### Participation in the Training of Trainers Workshop on the Simulation Game

To make the Simulation Game available to a broad range of researchers, we are offering a training for GLOHRA members to learn how to conduct the Simulation Game at their own research institutes. Interested members can apply for a one-day training on how to moderate the event for participants with diverse backgrounds. The online training will be for both - an online or on-site Simulation Game. Priority will be given to participants that participated in the simulation game in November 2021 and November 2024.

No specific background on NTDs is required for participating in the Simulation Game or ToT. Participants receive information on the scenario one day prior to the training. **We encourage early career researchers from all GLOHRA research areas to apply!**

## 3. Application and selection process

A total of 25 participants can join the Simulation Game and ToT. You can apply for both events in one application form, but you can also decide to apply only to the Simulation game or the ToT (if you already participated in November 2021).



**Please apply as early as possible, but no later than 6 November 2024.** We will select participants to ensure a balance of all GLOHRA research areas and expertise. Early applications and applications by early career researchers will be prioritized.
