Background

The GLOHRA Academy Series is a new format of the Global Health Academy that presents and discusses global health research from the perspectives of the different research disciplines of GLOHRA.

The Series directs special attention towards the added value of interdisciplinary and international cooperation in global health research. Every first Tuesday in a month, a speaker shares insights of his/her research projects while focusing on research processes, methods as well as lessons learned. Following the speaker's presentation, the Series encourages an academic exchange between the speaker and the audience in a Q&A session.

Speaker

Prof. Dr. Sebastian Vollmer, a representative of the GLOHRA research discipline Public Health, will present and discuss his multinational research collaboration on access to care for cardiometabolic diseases.

As the Professor of Development Economics in Göttingen, Prof. Vollmer's research examines the linkages between poverty and health in low- and middle-income countries. He has worked as a consultant for the World Bank, UNICEF, UNDP, UNAIDS, UNESCO, FAO, the Asian Development Bank and national government organizations. He currently serves as director of the Centre for Modern Indian Studies at the University of Göttingen and as the speaker of the Göttingen Platform for Global and Transregional Studies.
