3. Speaker

Prof. Dr. Clarissa Prazeres da Costa is a consultant microbiologist, immunologist and infectious disease specialist, long-term lecturer, co-founder and co-director of the Center for Global Health at the Technical University of Munich (TUM) and full professor heading her own research group "Parasite Immunology". For 14 years she has been the head of the diagnostic parasitology department and teaching unit in the Institute of Medical Microbiology, Immunology and Hygiene at TUM. Her scientific interests focus on basic immunological aspects of host-parasite interaction and type 2 immune disorders such as allergies as well as zoonotic and neglected tropical diseases (NTD) in relation to maternal and child health ranging from molecular studies, experimental models to clinical research in Africa. Her Global Health activities focus on NTDs, antimicrobial resistance (AMR) and Women's Health.
