

Applied Implementation Science Research in Global Healthcare, Systems, and Policy Settings

GLOHRA supported **on-site training** at the Heidelberg Institute of Global Health, Germany

OVERVIEW & PURPOSE

Implementation science research is critical for high impact of evidence-based interventions at local, regional and national levels. Knowledge and practice of these principles and methods are relatively new. This five-day intensive course will be facilitated by some of the field's global experts and aims to train early- and mid-career researchers in the field of implementation science.

Participants in this **hands-on training** will acquire skills to:

- **Formulate** relevant implementation research question and choose an appropriate study design.
- **Apply** theoretical models, research designs and measurement framework
- **Undertake** real-world implementation research
- **Implement** and translate research findings into policy and practice
- **Collaborate** and network within Germany and globally in the field of implementation science.

Participation in the training is free of charge. Pre-recorded online courses on the basic foundations of implementation science research are available at [GACD implementation science e-hub](#). All are invited to watch these online lectures as a means to gain an understanding of theories, methods, and frameworks relevant for implementation research.

The in-person 5-day intensive training on applied implementation science research will be held in Heidelberg and is open to 25 participants who are able to submit a successful application. A select number of travel grants will be made available for participants to attend the on-site training. The number of grants available remains to be decided.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

1. This course is intended for early- to mid-career researchers planning to conduct implementation research. Priority will be given to those with doctoral-level experience.
2. Eligible to be [GLOHRA](#) member
3. Ability to complete all 5-days of training.
4. Fluency in English language, as training will be delivered in English.
5. Limited travel support will be available for selected participants.
