



A Flipped Class on Qualitative Research in Global Health: Theory, Methods, Analysis, Write-Up and Dissemination

OVERVIEW & PURPOSE

This training offer is meant to support doctoral or postdoctoral students who will soon embark or are embarking on qualitative research within the field of global health. The training is structured into two components: a pre-recorded online course and a 5-day in-person workshop. All are invited to watch these online lectures to gain an understanding of theories, methods and analysis techniques inherent to qualitative research. These online lectures should be completed before the 5-day in-person workshop.

5-DAY IN-PERSON WORKSHOP

October 14-18, 2024
Heidelberg Institute of Global Health (HIGH), Ruprecht-Karls-Universität Heidelberg

Open to 15 participants who have completed the pre-recorded courses and are able to submit a draft protocol that will form the basis for discussion in the workshop.

Participating in the workshop is free of charge. A select number of travel grants will be made available for participants to engage in the workshop.

The number of grants available remains to be decided.

REQUIREMENTS FOR WORKSHOP PARTICIPATION

- Member of GLOHRA
- Currently undertaking research in Global Health at the doctoral or postdoctoral level
- Ability to complete all pre-recorded lectures (MOOC videos) prior to the workshop
- Eagerness to integrate qualitative methods into research that looks at achieving equity in health for all
