3. Speaker

Dr. Ellen Kuhlmann is a guest researcher at the Medizinische Hochschule Hanover with more than 15 years of teaching experience at various universities in Germany, England, Denmark and Sweden. Her research focuses on four areas with particular interest in international comparison and in global health policy: (1) healthcare systems, policy and governance, (2) health workforce governance and professions, (3) organization and management, (4) gender and public health.

Ellen's research interests reflect her own professional background as registered nurse specialized in intensive care/anaesthesiology, Master Public Health, and a PhD and post-doc qualification (Habilitation) in sociology with theses addressing issues of healthcare, policy and professions and gender relations. She is President of the section 'Health Workforce Research' of the European Public Health Association and has previously held similar positions on international boards.
